DISASTER MANAGEMENT MASTER PROGRAMME (MA)

The aim of the course is to educate professionals with higher education for the disaster management, who are able to work in the middle and senior management positions of the Ministry of the Interior, Disaster Management, Professional Fire Department, Municipal Fire Department, Industrial Fire Stations, administrative and economic bodies. They are also able to organize and manage the planning of protection in the fields of disaster management, fire protection (firefighting) and industrial safety.

Our goal is for students who have completed a master's degree to become familiar with the legal knowledge, security policy, human resources and the planning and organisational methodology related to the management and administration of disaster management.

Students learn the necessary knowledge of management psychology and managerial communication and the knowledge of disaster management. In addition, they learn about the administrative and defense administration and the system of international assistance.

Graduates of the master's program are suitable:

- to recognize the links between emergency communication and management;
- to perform decision-making and decision preparation tasks;
- to handle international affairs;
- develop problem and solution analysis for decision proposals;
- to manage the conflict situations,
- to apply effective negotiation techniques;
- to perform managerial and executive duties;
- in the field of home affairs, to perform middle and senior management positions in the field of law enforcement.
- to use management tools that best meet the professional requirements of industrial safety, civil protection, firefighting and rescue operations management, including modern management techniques and organizational solutions.
